Of the
CASACDE RADIO CLUB, INC.

SECTION 1: It shall also be the duties of the secretary to keep the constitution and By-laws of the Cascade Radio Club Incorporated. And to have same with (him/her) at every regular or special meeting, (He/She) shall note all amendments, changes or additions thereon and shall permit them to be consulted by any member on request.

SECTION 2: Applications for membership shall be submitted to the secretary in writing. And each applicant must express a willingness thereon to abide by the constitution and By-laws and such rules as may from time to time be made by the board of trustees. Applications for membership shall be accompanied by one year's dues. As an initiation fee, unless the period from the date of the application to the next date when the dues are regularly payable is less than six months, in which case. One half years dues will be required. This fee shall be returned to an applicant not accepted by the club. A majority vote of the membership present at any meeting shall be required for acceptance into the Cascade Radio Club.

SECTION 3: Regular meetings of the club shall be held on the third Wednesday of the month. Meetings of the board of trustees shall be held by order of the President whenever required for conducting club business, or may be called by the president upon the written request of any five members of the club. All members shall receive notification of such meeting twenty four hours prior to the time of the meeting

SECTION 4: A regular annual assessment of Five Dollars per member. And a family membership of Ten dollars, payable on the first of October each year is assessed in accordance with article VI of the constitution for the purpose of providing funds for current expenses. Dues shall be paid to the Treasurer who shall issue a membership card, showing expiration date and signed by the president and treasurer.

SECTION 5: There shall be a TVI committee composed of three members, appointed by the president. Whose duties it shall be to investigate all complaints of interference brought to their attention to determine if such interference is due to amateur radio operations. Advise the owner of a Radio or television set interfered with, as to the best means of eliminating the problem if an amateur radio is not at fault: To check the transmitter of any amateur upon request and to report their activities at every regular meeting.

Membership on the TVI committee shall be rotated among the members from time to time at the discretion of the president.

A motion was made to change the Club By Laws to read Dues are due as Of the first of January of 2007. Dues Paid now are good until January of 2008. New members between July 1, 2007 and thru Dec. 31, 07 will pay \$5 for single, \$10 for family.

A motion was made to change the election of officers as follows: Starting in 2007 nominations will begin in October, continue at the November meeting, and the election will be held at that meeting. New officers will take office in January 2008. Officers elected tonight will take office in November 2006 as under the former laws.
